## COVID ARRANGEMENTS

- 1 As at 2 December 2021, Victorian Government COVID laws allow people to attend an event who are:
  - Double vaccinated; or
  - Hold an Australian Immunisation Register medical exemption form.
- 2 Any Club holding an event is required to check that all persons attending check in using the Services Victoria app **AND**
  - a) sight the proof of double vaccination on the COVID-19 digital certificate via the Services Victoria app; or
  - b) sight the printed copy of the COVID -19 digital certificate together with a photo ID; or
  - c) sight the printed copy of the immunisation history certificate together with a photo ID; or
  - d) sight the Australian Immunisation Register medical exemption form together with photo ID.
- 3 Oaklands will have a marshal at the entry gate to the grounds who will ask all persons attending to check in using the Services Victoria app and will sight the documents in a) to d) listed above, as applicable.
- 4 Please wait at the gate whilst the marshal checks in all persons in a vehicle. No person should get out of the vehicle until they are checked in.
- 5 Neither Oaklands or the marshal will retain a copy of any immunisation documents.
- 6 Any person who is not able to check in successfully as set out in 2 above will be required to immediately leave the grounds.
- 7 Given the requirement to dedicate one person as a marshal at the gate throughout the event, entry to the grounds will only be permitted between the hours of 10.00am to 7.00pm on Friday and from 7.00am on Saturday and Sunday.
- 8 Sit down meals whether inside or outside are considered hospitality, under COVID rules, not a sporting activity. As a result, Oaklands will not be organising an event dinner, but instead, will have the BBQ available for people to use. BYO meat and salads.

## PROOF OF COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS

Customers aged 16 or over must show proof of COVID-19 vaccination or a signed medical exemption as a condition of entry to most businesses. **Here is what is accepted:**

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The event will be judged under the current Rules for Australian Carriage Society Combined Driving Events (effective 15 October 2020) plus any additional conditions in this schedule including:

- This event will be self-stewarding. It is a condition of entry that each competitor either stewards themselves or arranges a steward.
- Drivers must be full members of the ACDS.
- The Organising Committee reserve the right to:
  - Alter the advertised time
  - Refuse entry, with/without stating reason/s
  - Measure any horse or pony
  - Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class
- Grading will be taken as at close of entries
- All horses competing must be ACDS registered.
- Minimum wheel widths apply – wheels will be measured.
- Entry fees are non-refundable after the event commences. If a horse or driver is unable to attend due to sickness or accident, an application for refund may be considered by the Organising Committee on production of a medical or veterinary certificate. 30% of entry fees will be retained to cover costs. Requests for refund will not be considered after commencement of the event.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

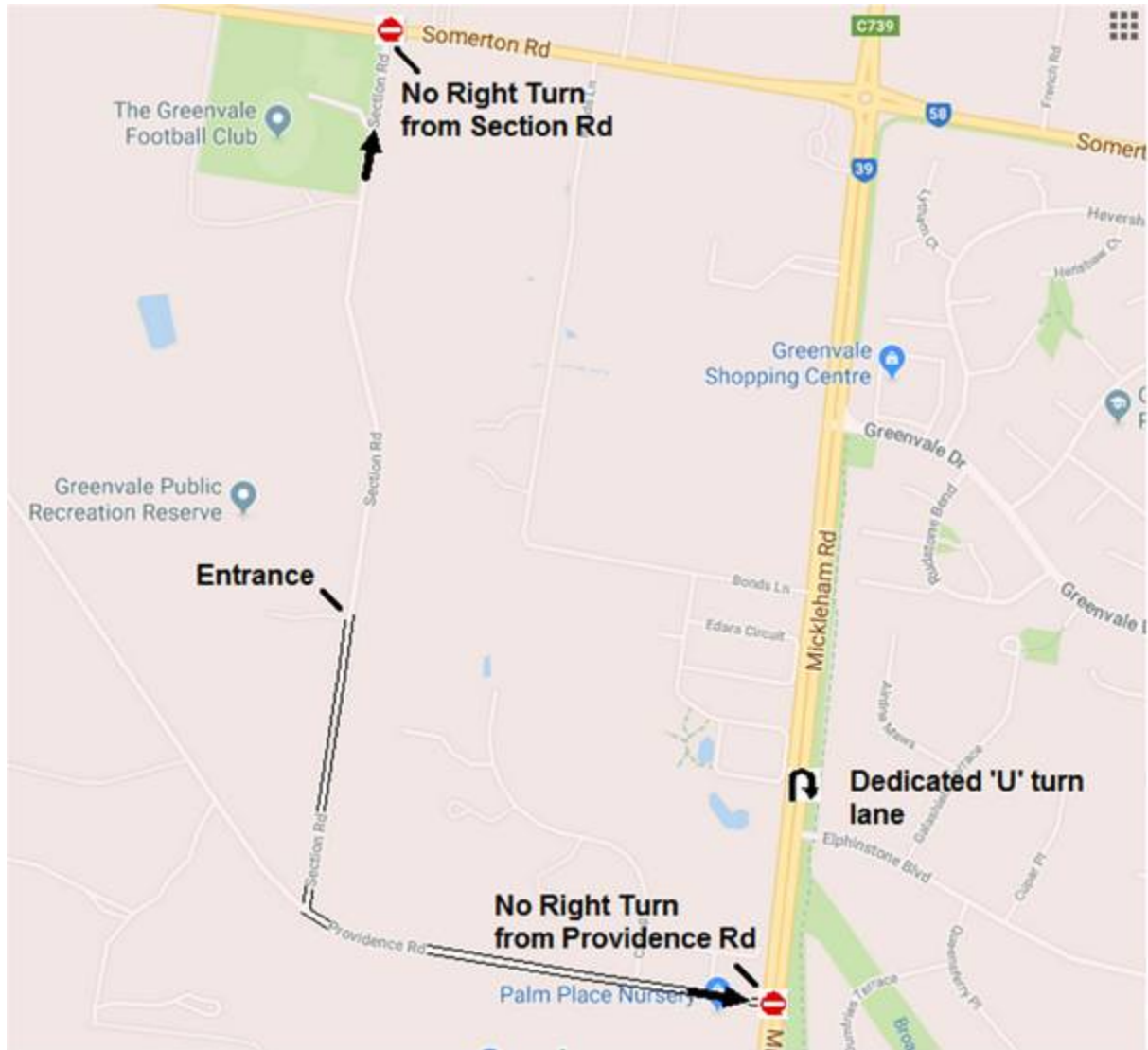
<b>Arrival and Departure Date</b>	No arrivals before 10am on Friday 28 January 2022 without prior consent of Event Director or Secretary. Gates will be closed at 7pm on Friday night. Arrivals from 7am on Saturday and Sunday.  All competitors must leave the event location by Sunday 30 January 2022 unless prior arrangements have been made with Event Secretary.
<b>Safety</b>	The reserve and neighbouring areas including the Woodlands Historic Park are home to a large kangaroo population. <b>For that reason, MO's, the dressage arena and cones course are not to be walked before 7am and after 8.00pm at night.</b>
<b>Vet Checks</b>	All horses/ponies to be presented in open bitted bridles. Competitors/handlers must be neatly dressed. Competitors/handlers must wear their competitor number to the vet check.
<b>Dressage and Dressage Times</b>	Dressage times will be posted at the competition location at 12 noon on <b>Friday 28 January 2022</b> . Dressage arena will be open to walk at 1pm on <b>Friday 28 January 2022</b> and also prior to the commencement of dressage.
<b>Marathon</b>	The course will be three sections over a maximum distance of 18 kms with up to six obstacles, some of which may be water. The countryside is undulating with mainly un-made roads. Section B of the course will be open for inspection from <b>7am on Saturday 28 January 2022. Sections A and the Transfer Section are closed</b> to motorised vehicles but are open to walking or riding on a pushbike. Competitors will be able to drive motorised vehicles to the obstacles only on Section B subject to weather conditions. Road laws for Victoria apply. It is the responsibility of the competitor to present themselves at the start of section A 10 minutes before their commencement time.
<b>Cones</b>	The Cones will be driven as a fault competition. The Course may contain a bridge and/or water. The Cones course will be officially open for inspection between 7.00am and 8.30am on Saturday 29 January 2022.
<b>Junior Persons (drivers/grooms/others) on Carriages</b>	Any person on a carriage who is under 18 years of age must wear protective headgear in accordance with ACDS by-laws.
<b>Awards</b>	Ribbons awarded to overall placegetters. Ribbons awarded to placegetters in each competition. The organisers take no responsibility for the loss of awards and/or prizes if recipients do not remain for the award ceremony at the conclusion of the event. <b>Competitors are expected to be appropriately dressed (dressage attire) for awards ceremony.</b>
<b>Catering</b>	As a result of the ongoing COVID requirements, there will be no catering at the event. The BBQ will be available for use on Saturday night. BYO meat and salads.

<b>Camping</b>	There are no powered sites. Please make your own arrangements. Generators are to be turned off at 9.30pm and only generators with a quiet motor are permitted.
<b>Showers &amp; Toilets</b>	Showers and toilets will be available.
<b>Accommodation</b>	For those not intending to camp, there are several motels within a 10 minute radius. Please make your own arrangements.
<b>Dogs</b>	Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a leash and controlled at all times. You are required to clean up after your dogs at all times.
<b>Yards</b>	Yards are available – cost \$10 per horse for the event.
<b>No Fires</b>	No fires are allowed on the reserve at any time.
<b>Rubbish</b>	Rubbish bins will be available for rubbish
<b>Local Shops</b>	Greenvale Shopping Centre is a 5 minute drive.
<b>Horses/ponies tied to floats/trucks</b>	All competitors need to be mindful of horse welfare and not have horses tied to truck/floats for extended periods of time.
<b>Helmets</b>	Helmets must be worn on all sections of the marathon and must comply with the ACDS by-law on helmets. If helmets are worn in other parts of the competition, they must comply with the ACDS by-law on helmets
<b>Medical Information Holders</b>	Properly completed medical information holders are compulsory for both drivers and grooms in Victoria and are to be worn and must be clearly visible at all times when on a carriage during the event.
<b>Melbourne Airport</b>	For those that wish to visit, Melbourne Tullamarine Airport is 10 minutes from Greenvale Equestrian Reserve.
<b>Tourist Activities/information</b>	City of Melbourne is about a 20 minute drive.  The adjacent Woodlands Historic Park is the home of Living Legends. A visit will enable you to rub shoulders with a number of Melbourne Cup winners. There is also the old homestead where afternoon tea is served. For those aeroplane enthusiasts, you can sit on the veranda and watch the planes take-off and land.
