Organisers Rights:

- Measure horses or ponies
- Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class
- Penalise competitors for unsafe or cruel practices

All competitors compete at their own risk. The ACDS, Goyder Plains Carriage Driving Club and private property owners will not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, equipment or property, owners, drivers, spectators or any other person in connection with this event.

In accordance with the regulations as set down in the ACDS insurance, each ACDS member agrees to pay the excess which applies to any insurance claim.

Conditions of Entry

1. The event will be judged under the Rules for Australian Carriage Driving Society Combined Driving Events effective 15th October 2020, and additional regulations as specified in this schedule.
2. Drivers must be full ACDS financial members of an ACDS affiliated club.
3. Whenever helmets are worn for equine-related activities at ACDS events, they must comply with the current ACDS CDE Rules as of 1 January 2017. Competitors must make an assessment of the condition of any helmet/s used to ensure they meets the requirements (see acceptance declaration on entry form)

Helmets are compulsory for Marathon Section.

4. All Junior Drivers aged between 12 & 16 must be accompanied by a financial ACDS adult groom. Junior Grooms must be a minimum of 10 yrs for Singles & 14 yrs for Multiples and wear securely fastened protective headgear in accordance with Art 928.2.2
5. Whenever a horse is harnessed to a vehicle, an ACDS member must be holding the reins
6. Appeals are to be lodged in writing with the Event Secretary & accompanied by a payment of \$50.00. The appeal must be lodged within 30 minutes of the scores being officially posted. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
7. All turnouts compete at their own risk. (See Disclaimer)
8. **Dogs are not encouraged at this event, but if brought, must remain on leash at all times. Owners must clean up after their dogs.**
9. Entries will not be accepted without nomination fee & a completed & signed entry form.
10. Any competitor late for a scheduled starting time may be awarded time penalties and/or be given a re-scheduled time.
