CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- You MUST use & complete the QR Code scan in when entering the Leighdale Site.
- The Event will be judged under the current Australian Indoor/Outdoor Horse Driving Rules and any additional conditions included in this
- Drivers must be full members of the ACDS and horses must be minimum 4 years of age and ACDS registered. All competitors compete at their own risk.
- Junior drivers age, 6-10 must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person) seated next to the driver at all times and holding a second pair of reins attached to the bit. Junior Drivers 11-15 must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person).
- Livestock control: Entrants /Owners of livestock are advised that horses must be adequately and securely restrained and controlled at all times.
- Dress code: Marathon gear, gloves and whip. Protective headgear is compulsory in accordance with ACDS rules.
- Properly completed medical information bands to be worn by all Drivers & Grooms, and must be clearly visible at all times.
- Parents are responsible for the supervision of children at all times at this
- Only the horses/ponies listed on the official entry are able to attend this event. Permission to bring additional horses/ponies must be sought and granted by the Organizing Committee prior to the close of entries.
- 10. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Manure to be bagged and binned.
- 11. No manure or fodder is to be left in the yards, beside floats or in the camping area. Discard in the manure pit provided onsite.
- 12. Any Special requests must be made to the event secretary in writing PRIOR to the close of entries.
- 13. Refunds will only be issued in accordance with the GDCD Refund Policy available to view via the GDCD Facebook page under the files tab, can be supplied if requested.
- 14. Should any fodder, manure etc be left behind in any yards, constructed yards or beside your float/truck your entry to any GDCD events maybe declined going forward
