About Oaklands

Oaklands was formed in 1985 and is affiliated with the Australian Carriage Driving Society (ACDS) and Victorian Branch of the ACDS. Oaklands has been one of the largest driving clubs in Australia and were one of the founding clubs associated with the ACDS. Oaklands "Home-Ground" is located at Section Road Greenvale, near the Melbourne airport. Oaklands members are keen competitors and have showcased the sport at Equitana, Royal Melbourne Show, EA events, Junior school holiday camps and are strong supporters of the Whittlesea Agricultural Show and many other events. Members of Oaklands have driven at international driving events in the UK and Europe over many years since its incorporation. Members are also officials of the ACDS and Victorian branch, lending their time and experience to the administration of the society and sport and officiate at many events.

Club Grounds/Facilities

Grounds are located at Section Road Greenvale 3059 at the Greenvale Equestrian Centre – (at the rear of the Oaklands Junction – "Living Legends" and Gellibrand Park). The grounds are also home to Avenel & Bulla Adult Riders and Woodlands Pony Club. Presently, the grounds have permanent cross country/marathon obstacles, club rooms, storage facilities and access to the surrounding parks adjoining the reserve. The club has its own equipment required for hosting competitions of various types and has hosted a National CDE Championships and an FEI/EA/ACDS combined event.

Various Carriage Driving Disciplines are catered for including Indoor-Outdoor Competition, CDE's, Graded Driven Dressage and Show Driving events. The Club sponsors classes at the Whittlesea Agricultural annual show – promoting the Show Driving Harness Classes.

Dates of Activities

Primarily held on the 5th weekend in any month – but flexible with the other user groups.

Various breeds of ponies and horses ranging from Welsh/Shetland to Friesians, Fjords, Gelderlanders using varying carriages/vehicles are driven by Oaklands members in single & multiple combinations and disciplines.
